**Does your state submit minor source (aka non-majors) facility emissions to the EPA NEI? If your state does report minors, what categories or emissions threshold do you report?**

In 2014 AK reported emissions for all smaller sources that fell within EPA thresholds. Sources that emit less than 100 TPY were reported in the nonpoint. In general, we also included mobile point sources which include mobile drilling rigs, rock crushers, cement plants, soil remediation units .
