Hi Tom and Farren,

Please see the attached email for what California will be supplying to WRAP for Regional Haze. I wanted to add a few caveats to this.

1. California will be supplying a full replacement data set for the base (2014) and out year (2028) except for:
 - a. Wildfires
 - b. Biogenics
2. As this will be a complete replacement, we respectfully request that WRAP does not supplement our data for any sources (eg. Oil and Gas, prescribed burns, EGUs, ag burns, ect.) except the two listed above.
