Hello RHPWG EI & MP Subcommittee participant (Oregon DEQ),

The RHPWG EI & MP Subcommittee is conducting a review of the 2014 NEIv2 in WRAP states. The Subcommittee is reviewing emissions inventories for air quality modeling by the WRAP for Regional Haze Planning. We are asking states to review and provide comments on major emissions sectors in their state.

Examples of EI updates provided by states during the review:

- * Facilities emissions (some states have found point source data missing in the NEI)
- * Updates to the Residential Wood Combustion sector
- * Significant changes in unpaved road dust emissions from 2011 to 2014v2 NEI (Oregon has an increase of 149%)

The RHPWG wiki <http://views.cira.colostate.edu/wiki/wiki/9191> has a memo that describes the Round 1 comment process. The wiki also has tools to help states conduct their review, and comments received from states during the review process.

We have not received comments from Oregon on point source inventories. We would appreciate your assistance with the review.
