Hello again Farren,

Regarding the NEI data review, since Oregon went through EPA's QA/QC procedures for the 2014 NEI, we believe that the EPA data is accurate for Oregon point sources. Just to be on the safe-side, I did a little range-checking on the data you posted to the WIKI, shown in the attached charts: Oregon looks comparable to Washington, which again is a good sign to me. Oregon has the 29<sup>th</sup> highest facility (total CAPs) in the domain: PGE Boardman, which also seems reasonable and makes sense (see the second slide). The number of facilities for Oregon, as well as the average CAP emissions per source, fell in the middle of the pack with regard to all the states in the domain.
