General Plans for coming months

- ▶ Late March/early April: make another Smartfire2/BlueSky run using recently acquired data and known issues that can be improved (may call this previous)
 - ▶ USFS FACTS database
 - ▶ DOI NFPORS database
 - ▶ NC and KS changes from beta approach
 - New Jersey data coming soon
- ▶ April: Incorporate GA day-specific ag burn data into v1
- April 4th workgroup call: Discuss alternate future-year fire inventories (Tom Moore and Matt Mavko)
- Late April: provide results from latest Smartfire2/Bluesky run (pre-v1) to workgroup in time for discussion during May's call
- ▶ May: More quality assurance of pre-v1 and come up with list of tweaks/edits/corrections to do (including look at fuels labeled "Urban"; any feedback from air quality model evaluation)
- ▶ Late May/June: Make the tweaks/edits/corrections where possible

Still time for QA of beta and submitting new data

- Workgroup members are encouraged to examine 2016 beta emissions
- States or other organizations can still submit fire activity/information data or edits to previous submitted data
